Further Information on Access

For arriving at the Hotel Wimberger from the airport:

- Option 1:** Take the bus (Vienna Airport Lines) directly from the airport to the Wiener Westbahnhof (Western Station) (6 EUR) (departure every 20 or 30 minutes) – best way!! Then take the tram 18 or the tram 6 to end station Burggasse-Stadthalle (journey time: ~ 55 minutes)
- Option 2:** CAT (City Airport Train) (8 EUR) or S-Bahn (about 3 EUR) to station Landstrasse, Wien Mitte. Then take the subway U3 (direction Ottakring) to Wien Westbahnhof (1,5 EUR) U3 Station Westbahnhof. Then take the tram 18 or the tram 6 to end station Burggasse-Stadthalle (journey time: ~70 minutes)
- Option 3:** Taxi, about 35-40 EUR (journey time: ~ 40 minutes)

Public Transport: Tram 18 or the tram 6 in the direction Burggasse-Stadthalle to the end station
